



ALPHABET SHEET: SCRIPT

Items needed:

- ☐ Copies of ALPHABET Sheet
- ☐ Pencil for each student

Part 1 Steps:

1. Find the dotted line in the middle of the paper. Then, follow the dotted line and fold the paper in half. (Teacher models how to fold the paper).
2. Find Part 1A on your paper. Some of the letters have arrows, numbers, and dots. Pick up your pencil and write those letters, then put your pencil down.
3. (Monitor student writing and provide feedback as needed.)
4. We're going to say the names of all the alphabet letters. Point to each letter as we say it. (Lead students in saying the entire alphabet, pointing to each letter).
5. Flip your paper over. Find Part 1B. Now some of the letters are missing. There are no arrows, numbers, or dotted lines.
6. Pick up your pencil and write the missing letters. After you write each letter, flip back to Part 1A to check your work. (Model for students how to flip paper from Part 1B to Part 1A).
7. (Monitor student writing and provide feedback as needed.)
8. We're going to say the names of all the alphabet letters. Point to each letter as we say it. (Lead students in saying the entire alphabet).

Part 2 Steps:

1. Find Part 2A on your paper. Some of the letters have dotted lines. Pick up your pencil and write those letters, then put your pencil down.
2. (Monitor student writing and provide feedback as needed.)
3. We're going to say the names of all the alphabet letters. Point to each letter as we say it. (Lead students in saying the entire alphabet, pointing to each letter).
4. Flip your paper over. Find Part 2B. Now some of the letters are missing. There are no arrows, numbers, or dotted lines.





5. Pick up your pencil and write the missing letters. After you write each letter, flip back to Part 2A to check your work. (Model for students how to flip paper from Part 2B to Part 2A).
6. (Monitor student writing and provide feedback as needed).
7. We're going to say the names of all the alphabet letters. Point to each letter as we say it. (Lead students in saying the entire alphabet).
